

Sam Houston Race Park
Entry Policy Regarding EHV-1
Effective February 15, 2017

Due to the current environment regarding the neurological strain of Equine Herpes Virus (EHV-1), Sam Houston Race Park will be modifying the current Entry policy dated on January 16, 2017

Starting on Wednesday, February 15, 2017, Sam Houston Race Park will return to our standard policy regarding Valid Current Health Certificates with the following exception:

- The health certificate must include evidence of vaccination with an FDA approved modified live or killed virus vaccine for EHV-1, administered no less than 14 days and not more than 90 days prior to the date of entry. The certificate must include the date of vaccination, brand, serial number and expiration date for the vaccine.

This modification will eliminate the 72 hour health certificate requirement, which will revert back to our standard policy of a 30 day valid health certificate for horses traveling within Texas and a 30 day valid health certificate for horses traveling in from outside of Texas. All certificates MUST include, or be accompanied by, a negative Coggins and Piroplasmosis Test (except for Thoroughbreds) as well.

No horses (including pony horses) will be permitted to enter the grounds of Sam Houston Race Park if they are coming from a county with a facility or race track that is under quarantine for the EHV-1 Equine Herpesvirus, or if they are coming from a county adjacent to a county where quarantine has been issued.
