Veterinarian Bob O'Quinn's TxRC occupational license is hereby summarily suspended by the Lone Star Park Board of Stewards pending a hearing for practices detrimental to racing when he was observed medicating the horse Lillie Abbie inside the prohibited twenty four hour period before the eighth race at Lone Star Park on 06/29/12.

During the term of this suspension Dr. O'Quinn is denied access to all facilities under the jurisdiction of the Texas Racing Commission.

Upon being duly notified, Veterinarian Bob O'Quinn waived hearing and was fined three thousand five hundred dollars and suspended one year (06/29/12 thru 06/28/13) by the Lone Star Park Board of Stewards for injecting the horse "Lillie Abbie" with medications other than furosemide inside the twenty four hour period before the horse was to race in the eighth race at Lone Star Park on 06/29/12. Dr. O'Quinn was in possession of three other loaded syringes that were intended for the horse "Quest for A Kiss", also in the eighth race.

The LSP Board of Stewards hereby probate the final six months of the suspension (12/26/12 thru 06/28/13) on the condition of no further medication violations by Dr. O'Quinn during the probationary period.

During the term of this suspension, Dr. O'Quinn is denied access to all facilities under the jurisdiction of the TxRC.
