313.443          ACTION BY JOCKEYS, INTERFERENCE

On October 26, 2012, pursuant to its continuing jurisdiction, The Board of Stewards amended ruling LSP2801 in order to correct a clerical error and provide additional detail regarding the ruling.

Upon being duly notified, Jockey Blaine Russel Hadley appeared in a hearing before the Lone Star Park Board of Stewards on 10/20/12. After consideration of the evidence and testimony presented, the Lone Star Park Board of Stewards hereby suspends Jockey Blaine Russel Hadley's TxRC occupational license for seven calendar days (10/28/12 thru 11/03/12) for careless riding during the running of the ninth race at Lone Star Park on 10/05/12.

The Board of Stewards found the facts to be as follows: Mr. Hadley permitted the horse he was riding, Miss Rockin J, to drift to the left, interfering with horses #3 Sweet Pea Rf and #4 Andretti Jet.

The terms of this suspension do not prohibit riding in designated stake races provided that the jockey is named at time of entry. A day in which a jockey participates in one designated race while on suspension does not count as a suspension day.

On October 31, 2012, Executive Director Trout denied the request by letter and reinstated the suspension with a beginning date of November 4 and an end date of November 11, 2012.
