The Texas Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory (TVMDL) has informed the Texas Racing Commission that it found a discrepancy in the phenylbutazone testing conducted from October 7, 2013, through December 3, 2013. Consequently, TVMDL no longer supports any phenylbutazone positives it reported from tests conducted during this period of time. As a result, Executive Director Trout has rescinded all affected rulings issued by the Commission, including this ruling. A refund check for the fine payment has been issued to the licensee.
